

ORDINANCE NO. 2017-11

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SEC. 28-34 REGARDING USE OF THE DUCK CREEK QUARRY NORTH OF GLENDALE AVENUE

The Village Board of the Village of Howard, Brown County, Wisconsin, does ordain that Sec. 28-33, under Article II. Licenses of Chapter 28, Parks and Recreation, of the Village of Howard Municipal Code be amended to read as follows:

SECTION 1. Sec. 28-34. USE OF THE DUCK CREEK QUARRY NORTH OF GLENDALE AVENUE


- a. Access to the quarry is limited to the designated area along Glendale Avenue.
- b. Swimming is permitted in the designated area along Glendale Avenue. Diving or jumping into the quarry is prohibited.
- c. Boating is limited to non-motorized, carry-in boats only.
- d. All occupants in boat(s) must wear personal floatation devices (life jackets).
- e. Fishing is catch and release only. Spears, crossbows and nets are prohibited. No more than one fishing line per person.
- f. Possession of alcohol is prohibited at the quarry.
- g. Tampering with lifesaving equipment is prohibited.

SECTION 2. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect on and after its passage and publication.
