POLICY TITLE: Public Health and Welfare

AUTHORIZATION: Village Board Ordinance #2004-30

POLICY STATEMENT:

THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF HOWARD, BROWN COUNTY, WISCONSIN, DO ORDAIN THAT SECTIONS 11.07(10)(8), 11.07(16)(3) AND 11.07(16)(5), PUBLIC HEALTH AND WELFARE BE AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. 11.07(10) DEFINITIONS – For the purpose of this ordinance;

- (8) "Multiple-family dwelling" means a property containing 3 or more residential units, per lot of record, including those that are occupied seasonally.

SECTION 2. 11.07(16) SOLID WASTE COLLECTIN REGULATIONS.

- (3) Recyclable waste to include commingled and paper shall be collected by the Village for all residential properties up to and including 2 dwelling units, per lot of record, provided such waste is properly separated, handled, prepared, contained, stored and located in conformance with this subchapter and rules and regulations established and publicized by the Director of Public Works. Curbside recycling is mandatory and residents will be required to comply when they are served by a recycling route. Recycling waste collection shall be provided once every two weeks to each household for one container furnished by the Village. Recycling waste shall be placed out for collection separate from but next to other solid waste on the regular refuse collection day.

- (5) All non-residential business establishments and multi-family dwelling units shall be responsible for the disposal of solid waste and recyclable materials in accordance with Chapter 11.07 of Village Code. The Village shall not provide these services for any business establishment (commercial, industrial, manufacturing or other), multi-family dwelling units (defined as a dwelling that has more than a two-family dwelling unit, per recorded lot of record), non-profit organization or other organization not a single family or two-family dwelling unit. Those business establishments that also have a dwelling unit attached to the building will not be provided any solid waste or recyclable pickup services from the Village, as such establishments will be considered a non-residential unit in accordance with this ordinance.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect upon its adoption and publication.
