

ORDINANCE NO. 2010-12

AN ORDINANCE CREATING SECTION 50-1194 OF THE HOWARD MUNICIPAL CODE (ZONING ORDINANCE) RELATING TO BURIAL OF ELECTRICAL POWER AND COMMUNICATION LINES

WHEREAS the Village Clerk published a notice of public hearing regarding such proposed amendment to the Zoning Ordinance and a public hearing was held at the Village Hall on March 15, 2010 at 7:45 P.M., whereupon the Plan Commission heard all interested persons and/or their agents and attorneys; and

WHEREAS the Village Board of the Village of Howard has received a written recommendation and findings of the Village Plan Commission regarding such proposed amendment to the Zoning Ordinance;

NOW THEREFORE the Village Board of the Village of Howard, Brown County, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain that the Zoning Ordinance be amended as follows:

SECTION 1 Section 50-1194 is hereby created to read as follows:

Sec. 50.1194. - Burial of Electrical Power and Communication Lines

Whenever any private property in the Village is developed, as defined in Article 1, Sec. 50-6 of this chapter, all new and existing electrical power and communication lines, including but not limited to electric lines, telephone lines, cable television lines, etc., servicing such property, shall be buried underground in accordance with local and State regulations for such utility services. The provisions of this section shall not apply to electrical services of 600 volts or higher, or to pedestals, cabinets, transformers or other equipment designed and required to be installed above ground.

SECTION 2 All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3 This ordinance shall take effect upon its adoption and publication.
