

## ORDINANCE NO. 2010 – 13

### AN ORDINANCE REPEALING AND RECREATING SECTIONS 28-22(a) AND 28-23 RELATING TO PARK HOURS OF OPERATION AND DOG PARK REGULATIONS

THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF HOWARD, BROWN COUNTY, WISCONSIN, HEREBY ORDAINS THAT SECTIONS 28-22(a) AND 28-23 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF HOWARD BE REPEALED AND RECREATED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

#### **SECTION 1.**

##### **Sec. 28-22. Hours of operation.**

(a) *Park hours.* Unless a program or event is sponsored by the leisure services department, the following park hours shall apply:

- (1) Akzo Nobel Sports Complex-30 minutes before sunrise to 10:30 p.m. Lights to be shut off at 10:15 p.m.
- (2) Barney Williams Park-30 minutes before sunrise to 30 minutes after sunset.
- (3) Deerfield Docks –Open 24 hours for Fishing and Hunting purposes.
- (4) Deer Run Park-30 minutes before sunrise to 30 minutes after sunset.
- (5) Duck Creek Quarry-30 minutes before sunrise to 30 minutes after sunset.
- (6) Gordon Nauman Conservation Area/Howard Dog Park-30 minutes before sunrise to 30 minutes after sunset.
- (7) Hoff-Reinhard Wildlife Preserve-30 minutes before sunrise to 30 minutes after sunset.
- (8) Howard Memorial Park Diamonds and Fields-30 minutes before sunrise to 12:00 midnight.
- (9) Howard Memorial Park Boat Landing and Parking Lot-Open 24 hours for fishing, hunting, and water access purposes.
- (10) Juza-Oliver Family Park-30 minutes before sunrise to 30 minutes after sunset.
- (11) Lehner Park-30 minutes before sunrise to 30 minutes after sunset.
- (12) Meadowbrook Park-30 minutes before sunrise to 10 p.m.
- (13) Mills Center Park-30 minutes before sunrise to 30 minutes after sunset.
- (14) Pinewood Park-30 minutes before sunrise to 10 p.m.
- (15) Pioneer Parkway-30 minutes before sunrise to 30 minutes after sunset.
- (16) Spring Green Park-30 minutes before sunrise to 10 p.m.
- (17) Wayne Williams Conservation Area-30 minutes before sunrise to 30 minutes after sunset.
- (18) Wietor Wharf Park-Open 24 hours for fishing and hunting purposes.

#### **SECTION 2.**

##### **Sec. 28-23. Pets.**

The following rules shall apply to all Village Parks except for at the Howard Dog Park located at the Gordon Nauman Conservation Area.

(a) Dogs in village parks must be leashed at all times on a leash not longer than eight feet. Domestic pets shall be permitted on roads, sidewalks, trails, and natural areas where they will not interfere with the use of the parks by other persons. Pets shall not be allowed in buildings, playgrounds, picnic, sport, or public event areas.

(b) Rules for the Howard Dog Park located at the Gordon Nauman Conservation Area shall be as follows:

- 1) All dogs must be leashed at all times outside of the designated fenced areas.
- 2) Owners are legally responsible for their dogs and any injuries caused by them.
- 3) All dogs must be licensed and have current rabies vaccination per state law.
- 4) All dogs must wear owner identification tags.
- 5) Owners will be responsible for immediately clean up feces deposited by their dog and dispose of it in appropriate containers.
- 6) Owners shall not leave their dogs unattended or out of sight.
- 7) All dogs in season are prohibited.
- 8) All digging by dogs is prohibited.
- 9) No Food (human or dog) is allowed within the dog park.
- 10) Any violation of the general park rules and dog park rules will result in the removal from the park and suspension of park privileges.

**SECTION 3.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 4.** This ordinance shall take effect upon its adoption and publication.
