**RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE CONSTRUCTION OF A PEDESTRIAN CROSSWALK OVER US
HIGHWAY 41 IN THE VILLAGE OF HOWARD**

WHEREAS, the Village of Howard, Wisconsin believes it is essential to provide safe pedestrian and bicycle access over Highway 41; and

WHEREAS, the Village has promoted alternative means of transportation for its citizenry; and

WHEREAS, the Village has identified Taylor Street in its Bicycle Pedestrian and In-Line Skate Plan as a facility for alternative means of transportation; and

WHEREAS, the Village wishes to create safe, enjoyable recreation and transportation corridors for its residents and provide corridors that are readily accessible to walkers, runners, bicyclists and in-line skaters to connect to residential neighborhoods, schools, churches, parks and shopping areas.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Village Board of the Village of Howard, Wisconsin hereby supports the construction of a pedestrian overpass over U.S. Highway 41 between Memorial Drive and S.T.H. 29, contingent upon state or federal funding.
